- 6. What was Rama IV before he became king?
- 7. What discrepancies exist between Anna's version of her life and the 1979 film version of her life?
- 8. Why might Anna's mother have had to remarry so quickly?
- 9. Describe what life was like for women in the barracks.
- 10. What is an orientalist?
- 11. Who was Reverend Badger? What impact did he have on Anna's life?
- 12. What legacy did Anna leave behind in Nova Scotia? What was her goal?
