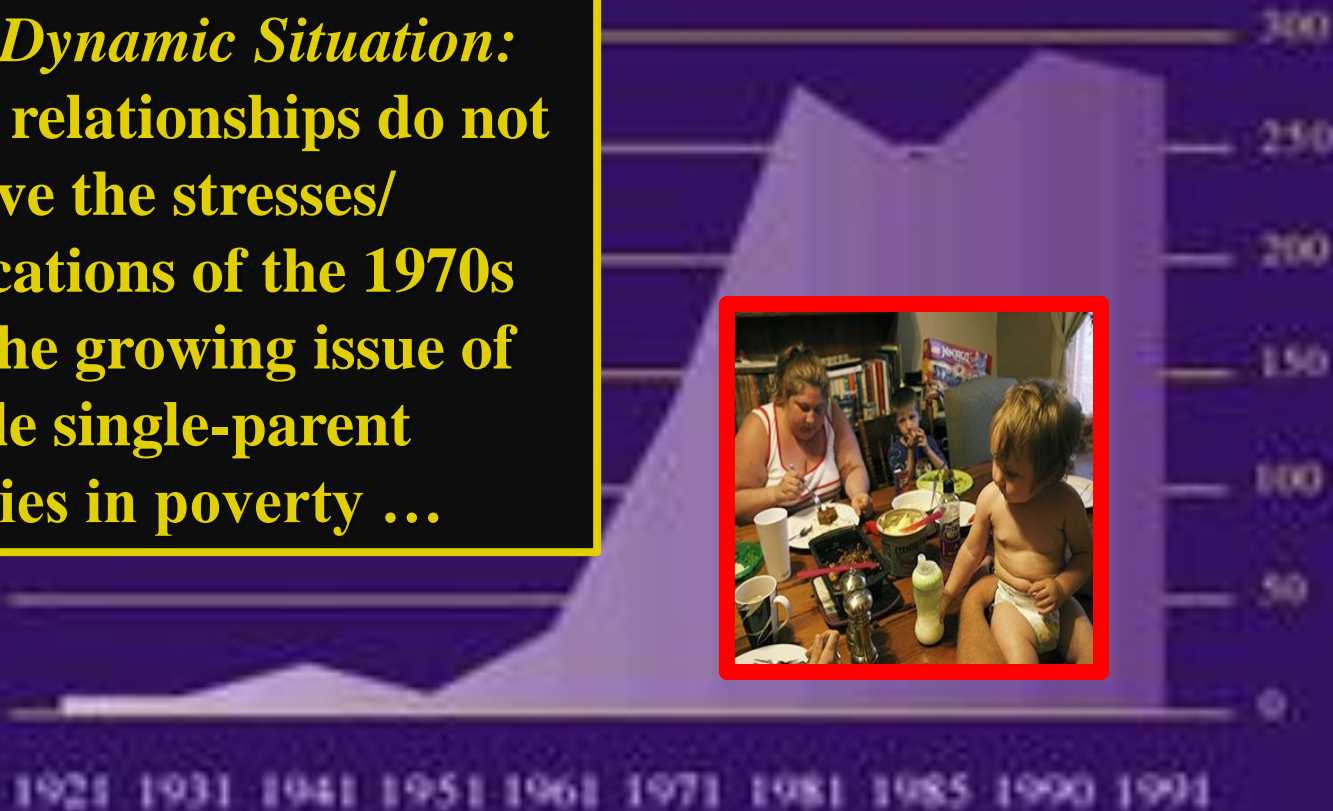
Incidence of Divorce in Canada 1921-1991

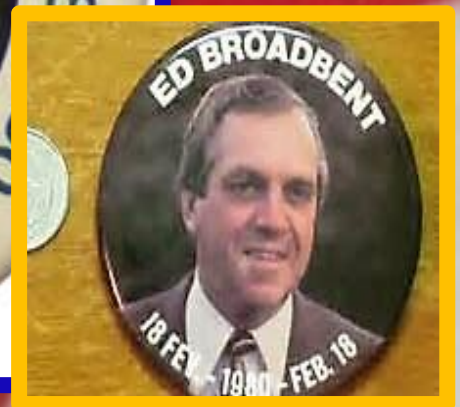
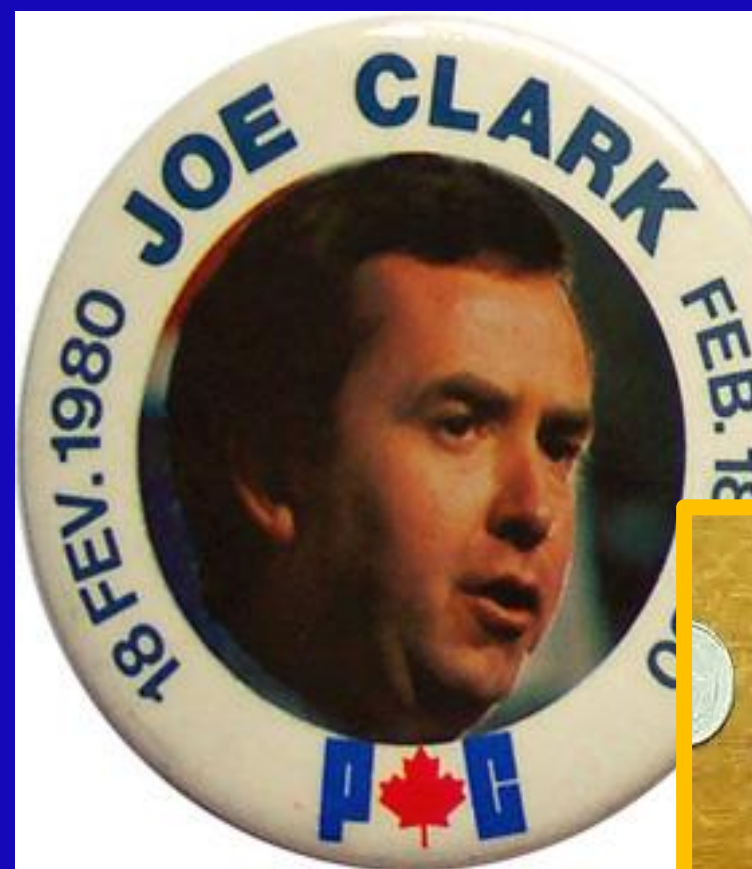

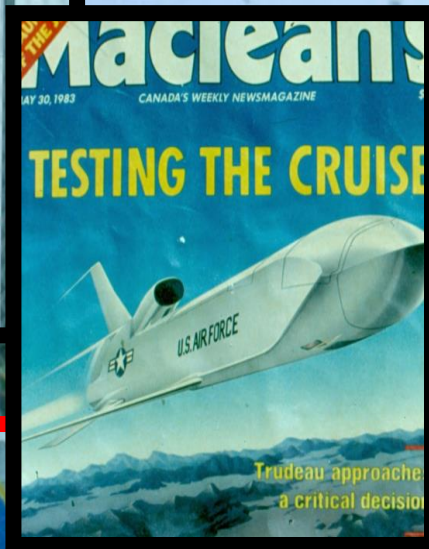

Families pray for trapped men

PLYMOUTH, N.S. — Rescue workers with oxygen tanks strapped to their backs picked their way through a methane-filled mine shaft yesterday, desperately trying to reach 26 coal miners trapped by an underground explosion.

"We're certainly hoping that the rescue teams are going to get there and that there's going to be good news," said RCMP Const. Ivan Baker.

"I think there's always hope."

Hope was all that hundreds of friends and relatives were clinging to last night — hope that the imprisoned men still had air to breathe, hope they would be found alive deep in the hot, black mine.

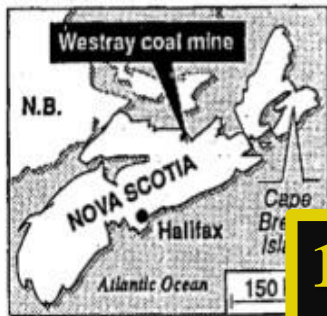
Baker said there had been no communication with the men since an explosion ripped

through the Westray mine at 5 p.m. yesterday. The blast, which rocked the town, tore away, knocked out power in the mine.

Workers were pumping oxygen but they did not know if it was

about 1.5 miles from the mine. Marshall felt the explosion immediately thought about the mine, where his 27-year-old son Robbie works.

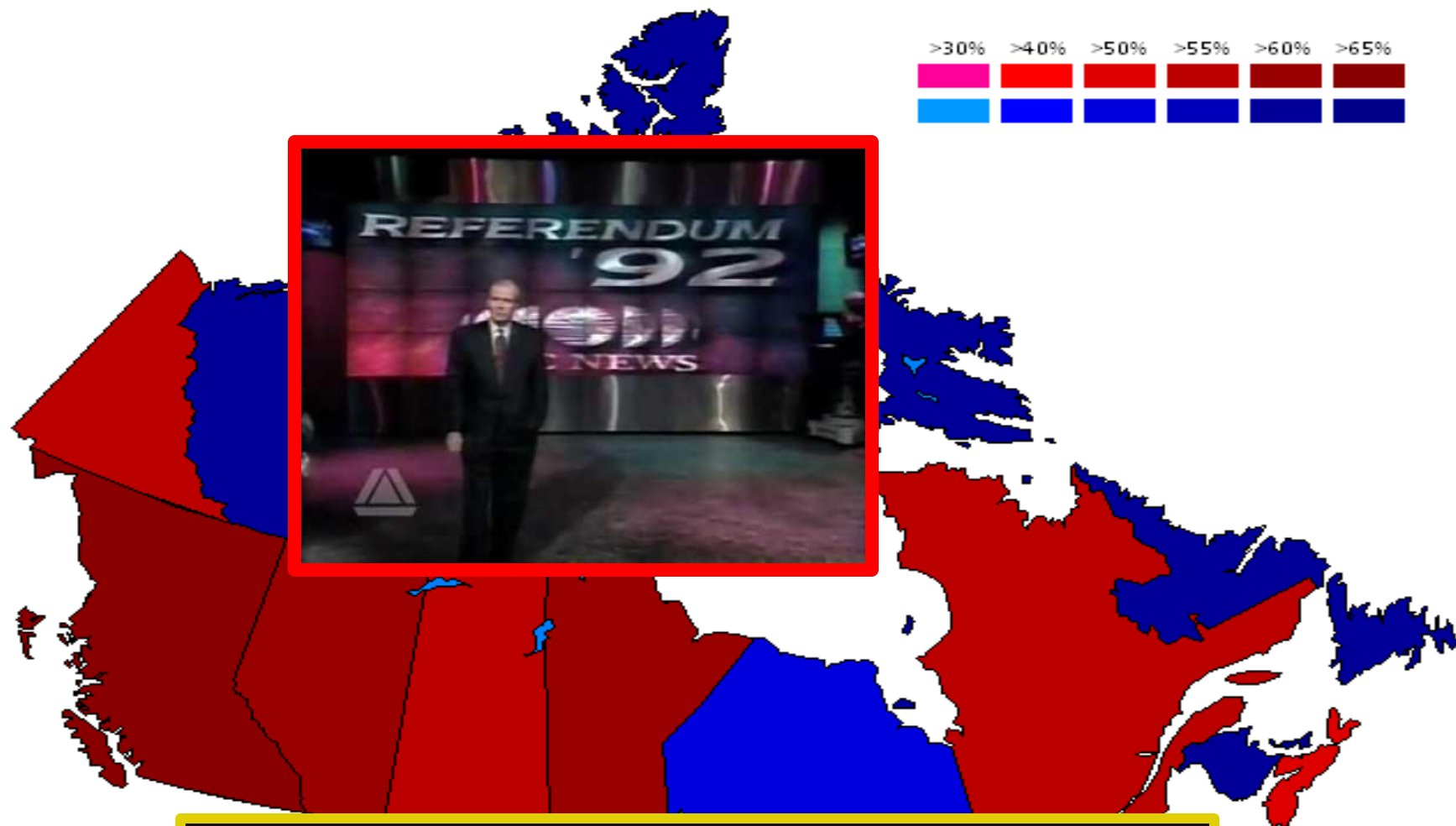

A WAVE OF GENEROSITY RUSHED OVER QUEBEC 10 Years After the Saguenay Flood

At 2:30 a.m., on the morning of July 19, 1996, a flood prompted one of the largest evacuation operations in Quebec's history. In the course of just a few hours, a heavy downpour hit north-eastern Quebec and caused substantial flooding in the Saguenay region as well as Charlevoix and the Côte-Nord.

On the 10th anniversary of the Saguenay flood, the Red Cross has chosen as a report of its activities relating to the event that will remain forever engraved in the collective memory of all Quebecers. This operation is one of the largest in the history of the Canadian Red Cross. Since 1996, 5,700 volunteers have provided Red Cross assistance to 10,000 people. The assistance program was carried out in six phases, all complementary to the assistance provided by the Quebec Government.



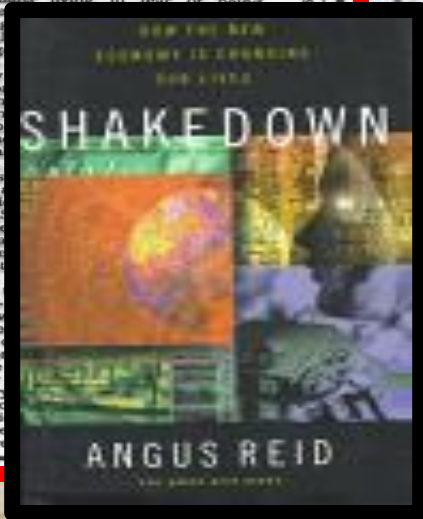
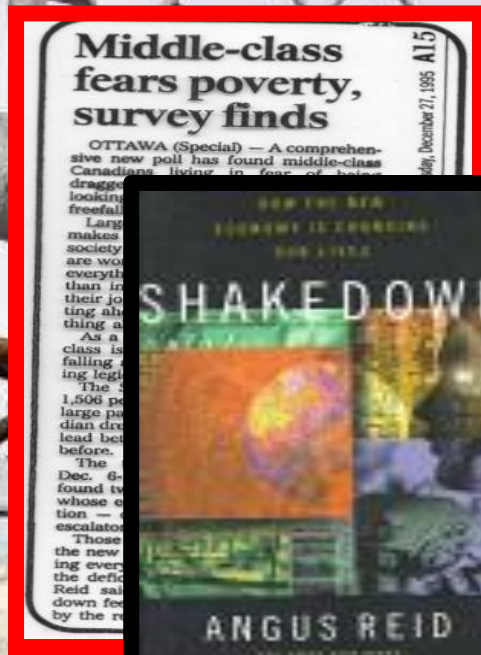
The generosity of donors from Quebec, Canada and elsewhere in the world enabled the Red Cross to give 27 million dollars to the affected population. Although relief operations are now over, the Red Cross continues to provide assistance to those families who are still dealing with the aftermath of the flood. Residents of Charlevoix, in Saguenay, whose homes are or will be from landslides, also benefited from Red Cross assistance through the South du Saguenay de la Saguenay in collaboration with the City of Saguenay. The funds received, \$500,000, is now available for the victims of future disasters in the Saguenay region or elsewhere in Quebec.



Never Before Seen Deployment

As soon as the emergency operation was launched, the Red Cross made clear that it was to intervene in the event of a disaster. At the same time, the Charlevoix office and local offering services including the registration of disaster victims. As early as Sunday morning, volunteers were working in the Saguenay area of the Saguenay. In the Saguenay, it was a task to help the victims of the flood.
